When is it? Crossing Kirkland will be held on Saturday, Sept. 8, 2018 from 11am to 4pm. In order to win a Kirkie you must officially register by August 15. Winners will be announced between 3-4pm.

Why should I participate? You mean, besides being the envy of your neighbors and relishing in the admiration of all who see your creation? Prizes will be awarded in a variety of categories including **Best Under 12** (average age of participants is 12 and under), **Most Original Bicycle-Based** entry, **Best Reuse of Recycled Materials**, and **Longest Distance Traversed**.

What sort of entrants might there be? Your imagination is the limit. Bling out your bicycle? Get some help from animals? Assemble your organization in costume? There are only a few requirements:

- Only non-motorized entries are allowed
- The width of your entry, all in, must be no more than eight feet
- No printed words, but organization or company logos are OK
- No fire or actual weapons
