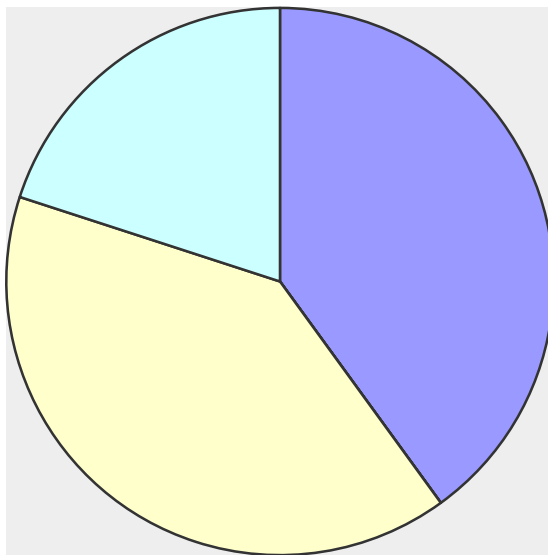

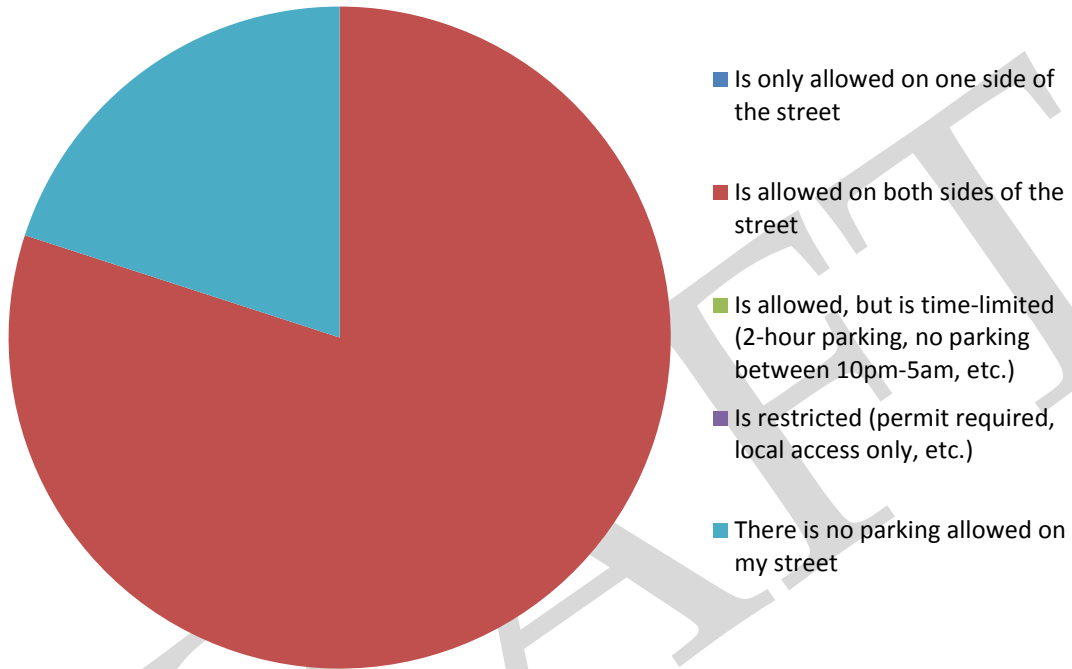

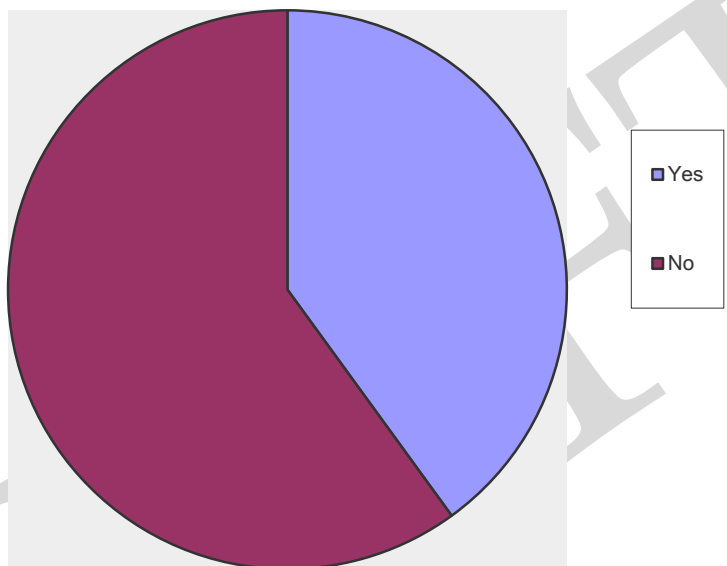

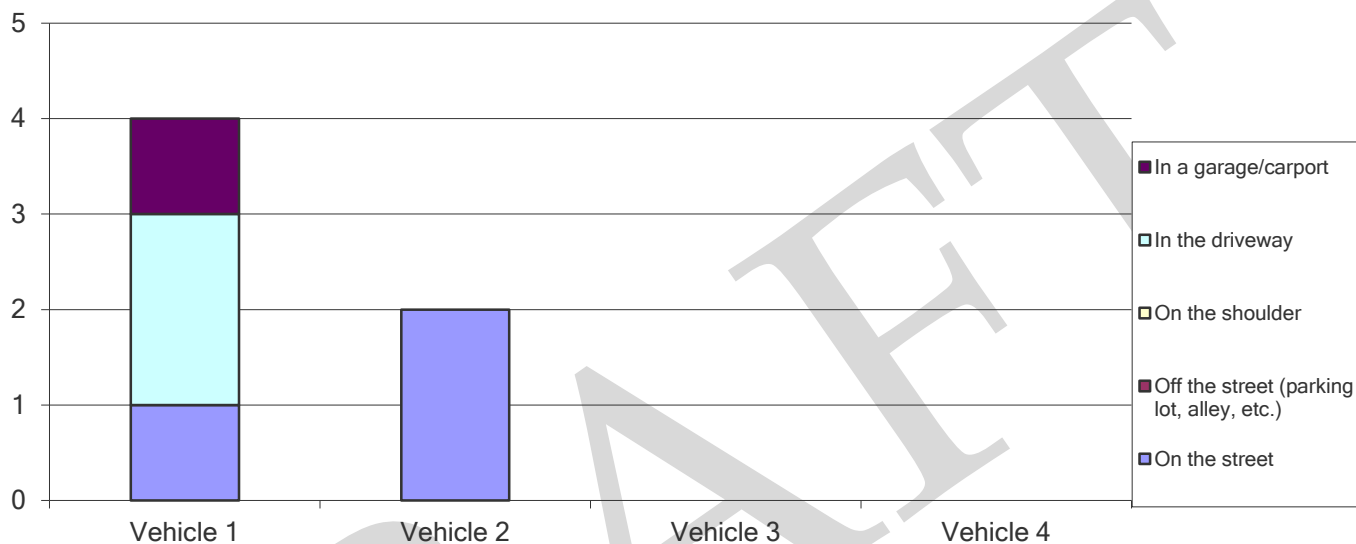

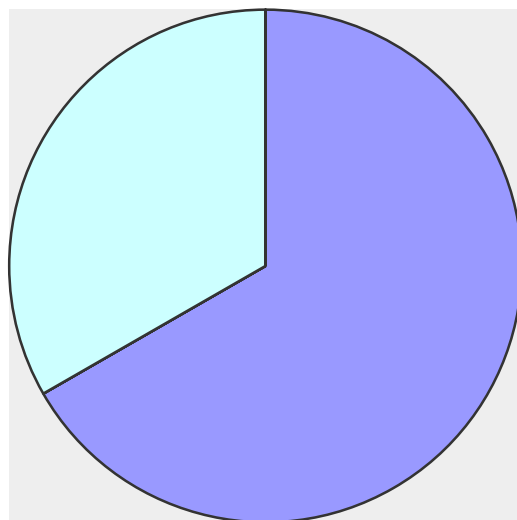

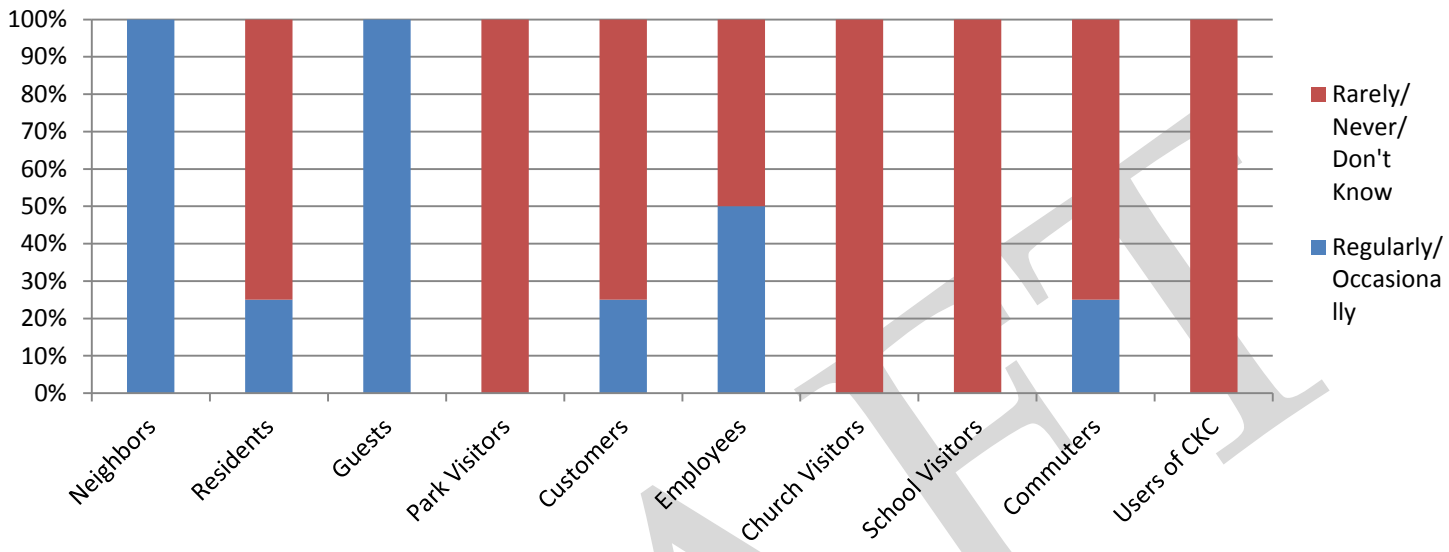

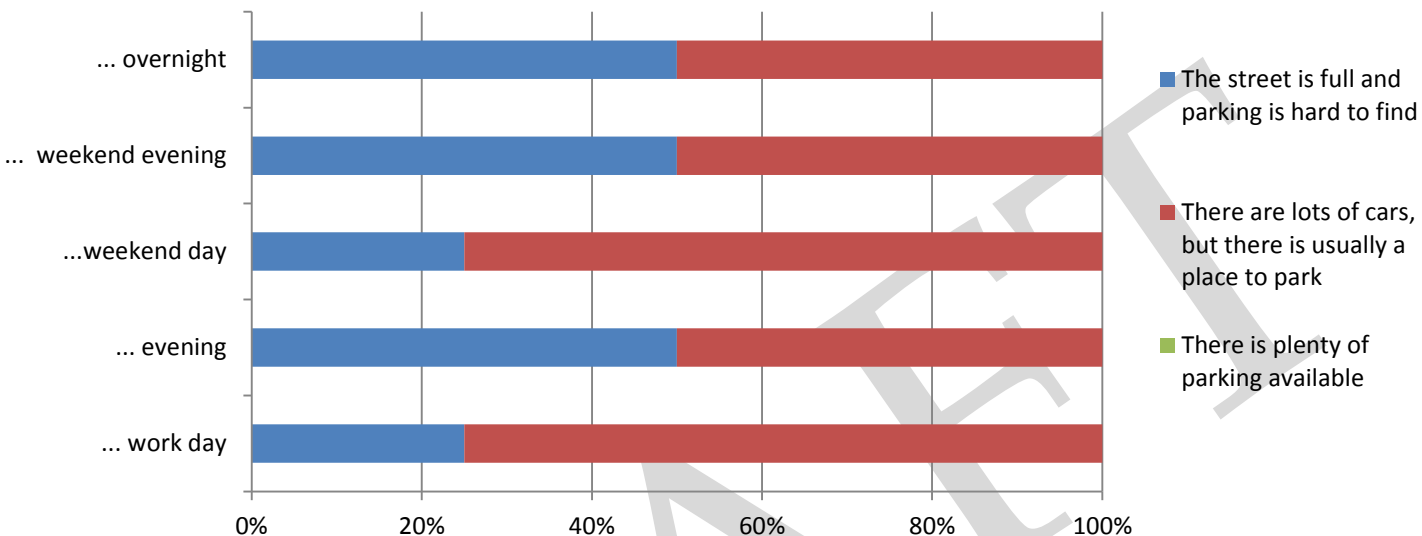

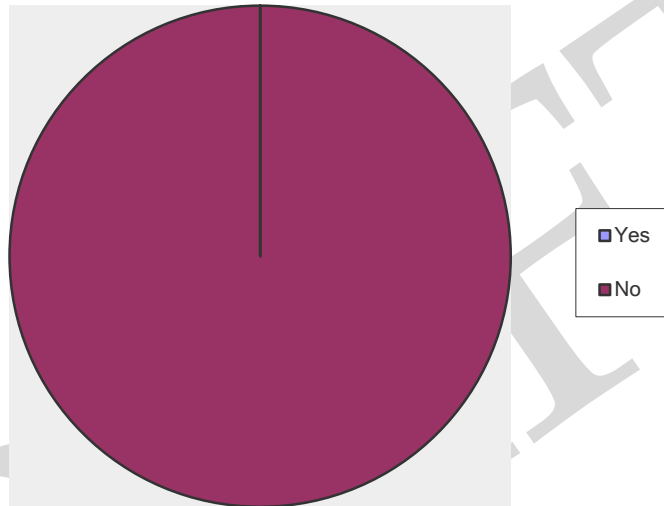

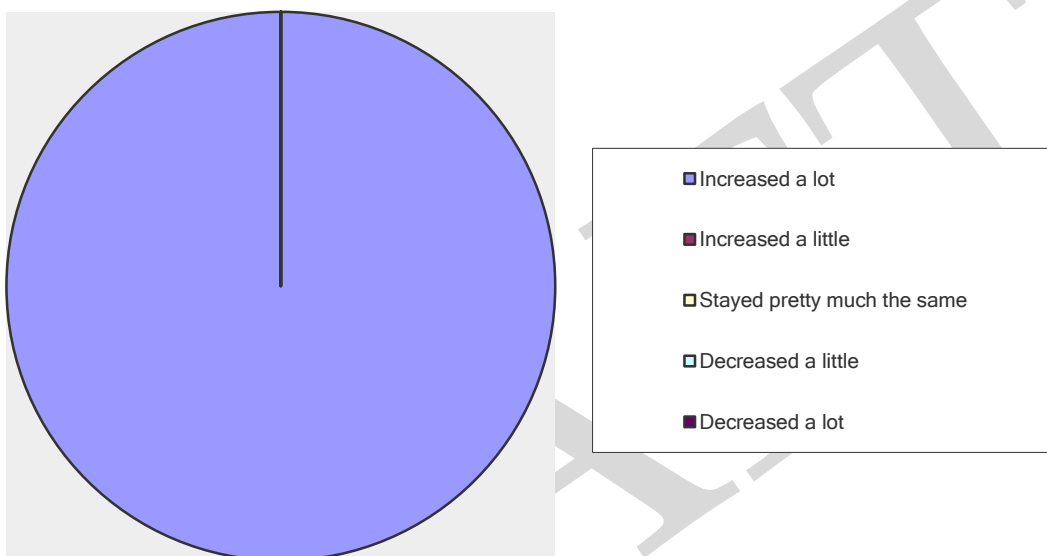

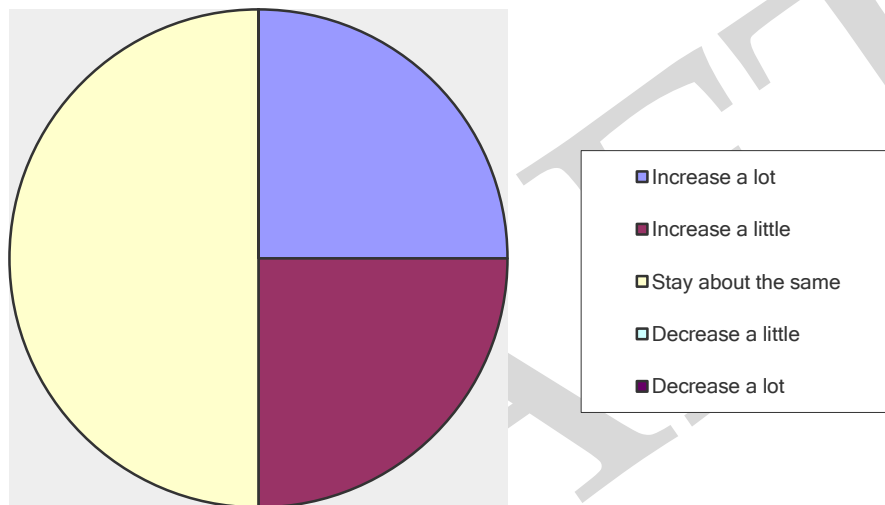

- two neighbors own a business one a daycare and one a lawn care company and the parking blows because of them.

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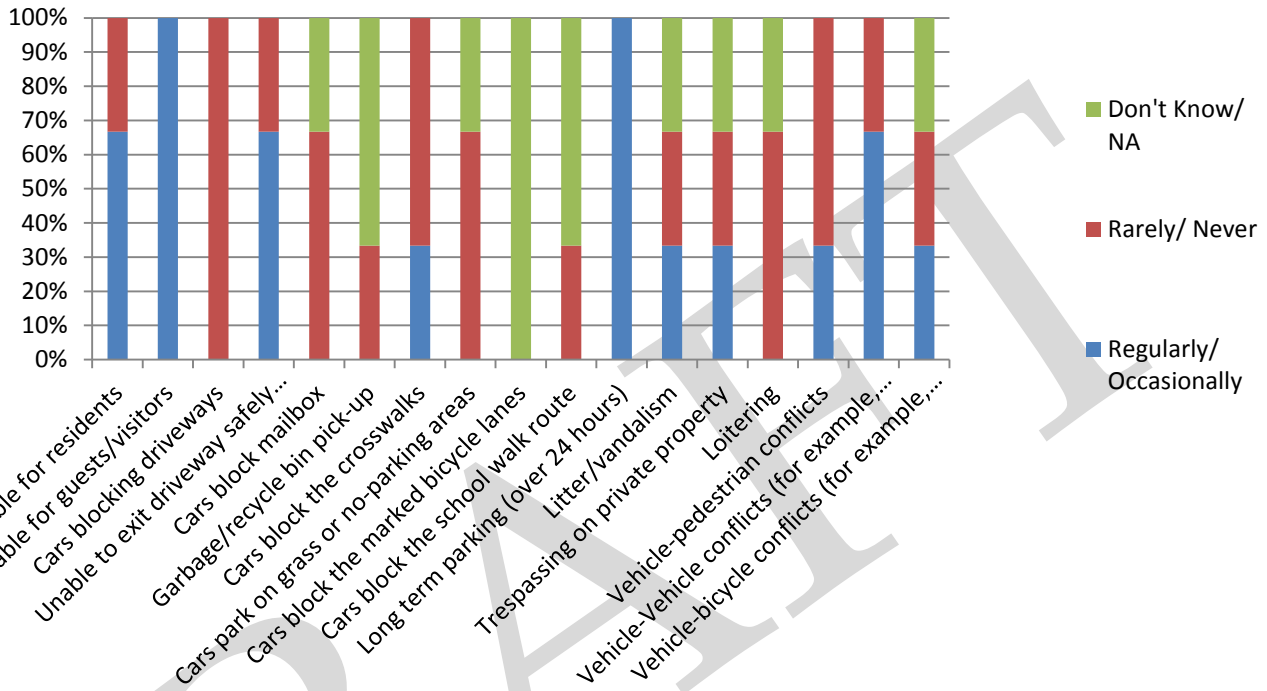

Comment: more retail going in, more households with 2 cars, complexes charging higher fees for garage parking that is NEVER part of the monthly rental.

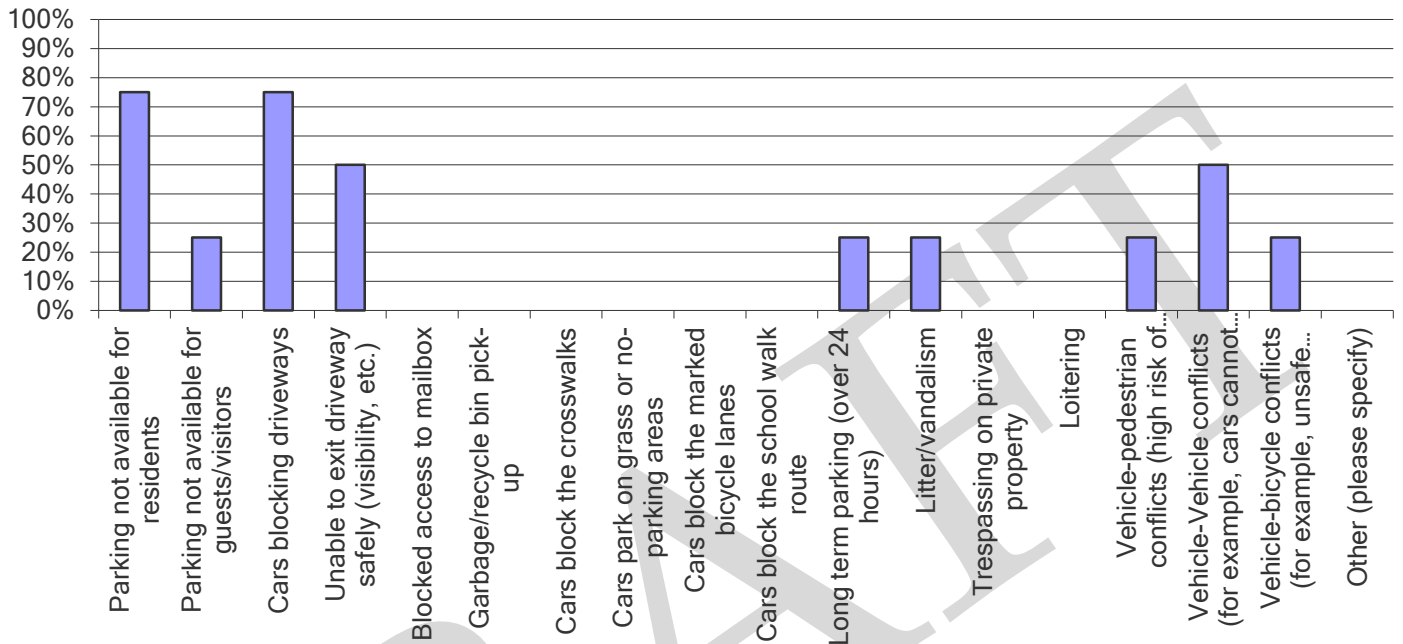

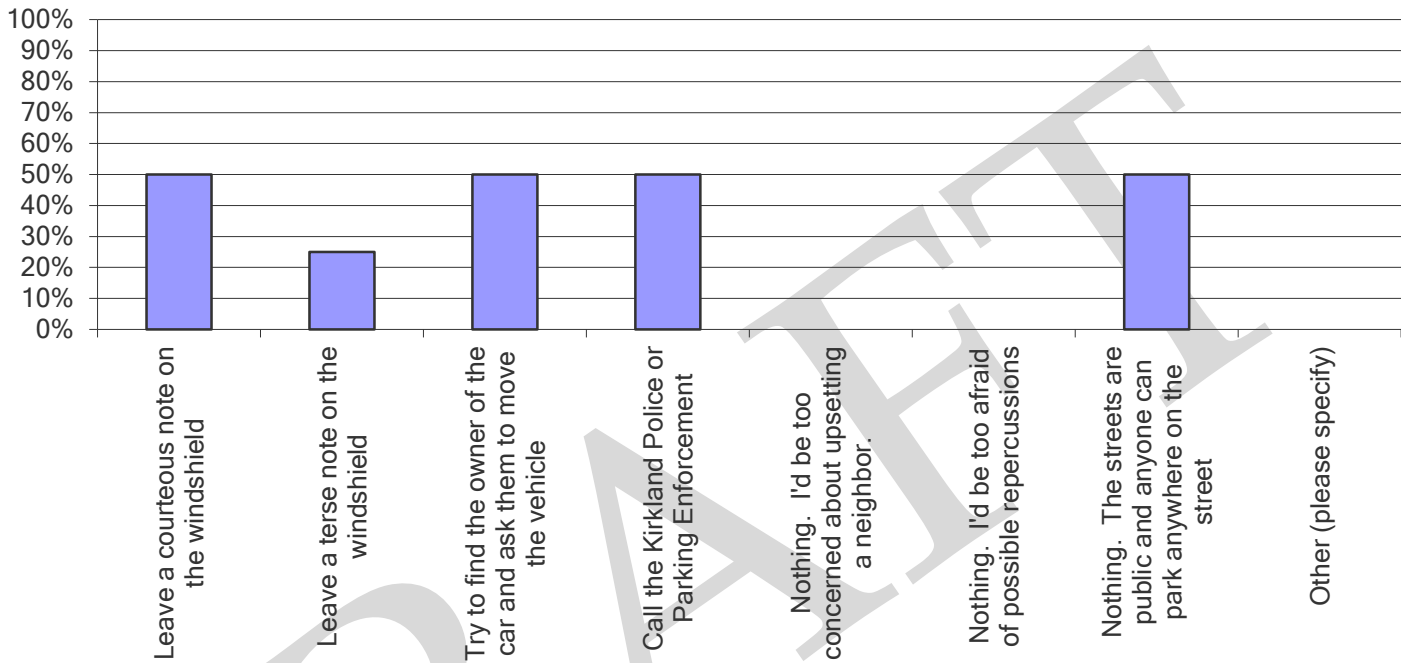
Comment: arrive home later in the evening during the workweek and you will have to park at least 3 blocks away from your destination and it doesn't feel safe.

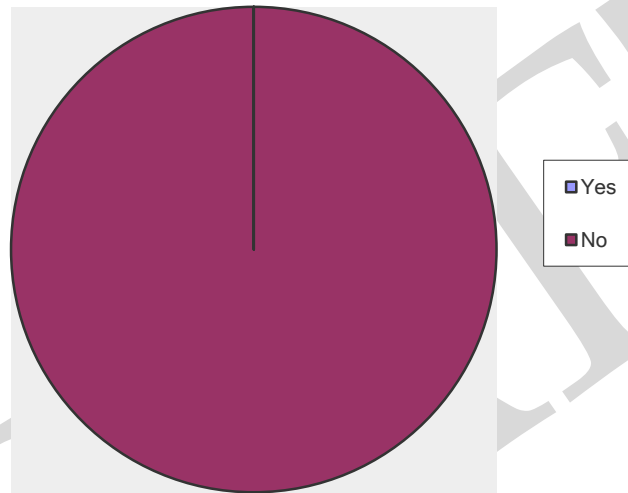

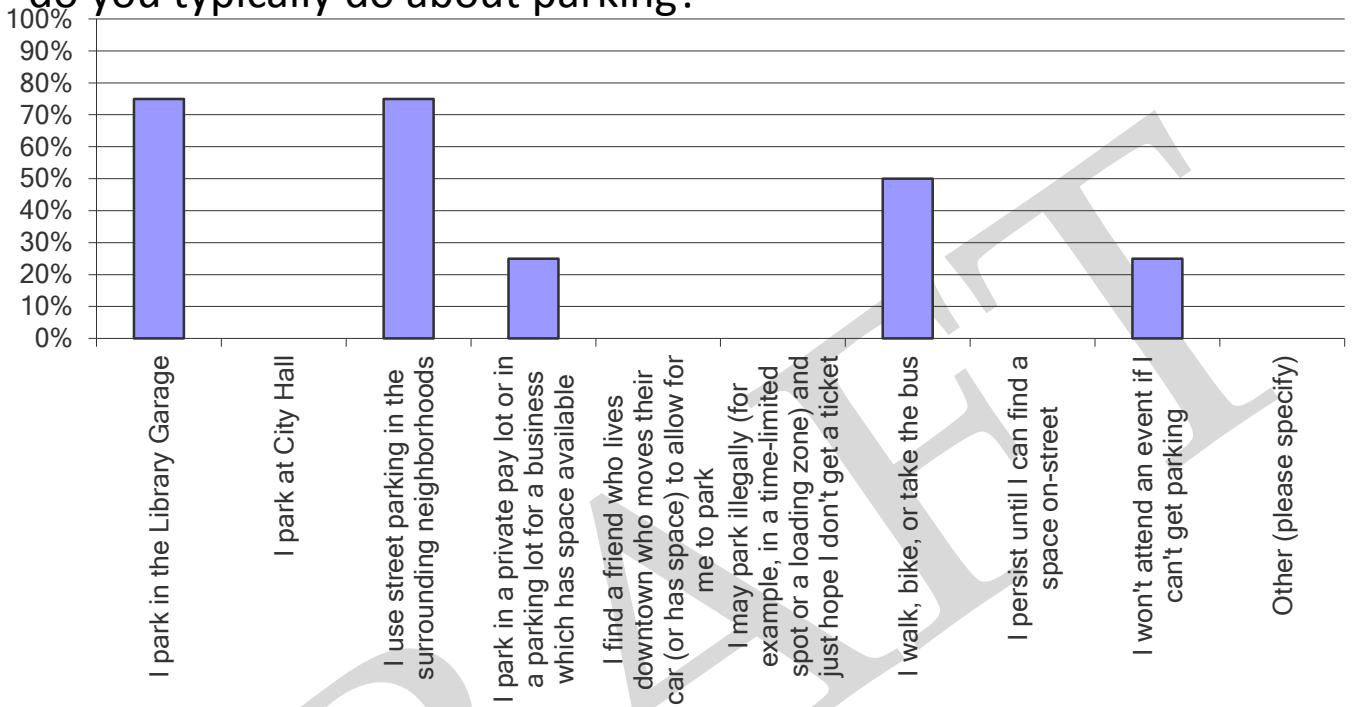

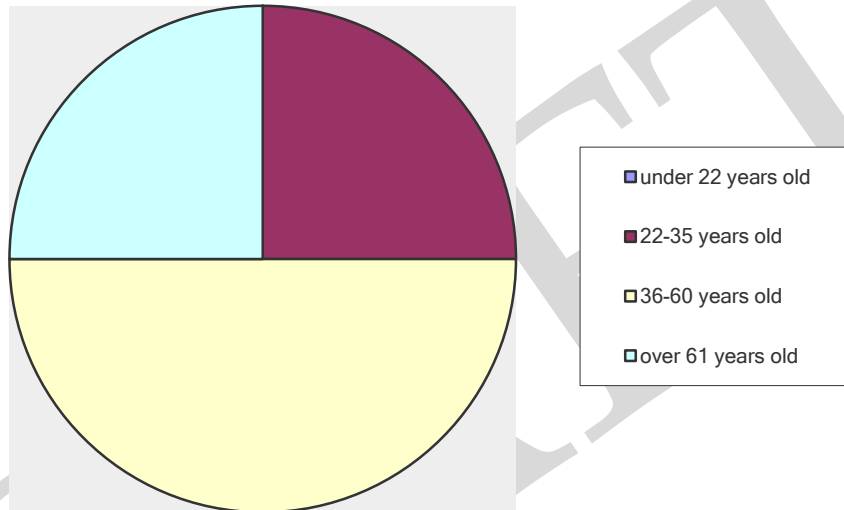
